 - The FAFSA forecaster (or FAFSA4Caster) calculates the amount of federal aid a student is eligible for based on a number of factors, such as age, income, school year, and anticipated cost of attendance. After filling in the necessary information, the student can view an estimate of his or her eligibility amount, broken down by type—this includes Federal Grants, Stafford Loans, and Work Study.
